At the meetings, speakers present topics of particular interest to our members. We also offer a facilitated support group. A social period allows members to circulate with new and old friends, meet the speakers, plan for future events and browse through our photo library.

Monthly social activities include dinner, lunch, theater and concerts, trips, and parties in members' homes.

Members receive our monthly newsletter *PROLOGUE*, outlining all activities, as well as other pertinent information.

Group discounts are frequently obtained for selected events.
